Symptoms Requiring School Absence

- Active vomiting or diarrhea (24-36 hours after last episode)
- Fever 100.0+/Chills/Body Aches (24-36 hours fever free without the use of fever reducing mediation)
- Cough accompanied with shortness of breath (Health Office Determination)
- 24 hours after initial dose of antibiotic (i.e... strep throat, pink eye, etc.)
- Undiagnosed, new, and/ or untreated rash or skin condition
- Head Lice- Nit and Lice free (must be screened by Nurse prior to returning to class)
- Doctors note requiring individualized plan of care to stay home

COVID-19

We will require that you pick up your student immediately if he / she exhibits two or more of the following symptoms:

- Fever 100.0 or higher
- Excessive Fatigue
- Dry Cough
- Muscle Aches or Weakness
- Shortness of Breath
- Loss of Taste or Smell

Parental Responsibility

Parents must pick up their students within 30 minutes once contacted by Health Office.

Notify school if student has a positive test for COVID-19 or other communicable illness.

Health Screening at School

All students will receive screenings for vision, color vision and eye muscle balance. You will be notified when a further evaluation by a specialist is recommended. Upon request, a student may also be checked anytime a concern arises from parent or teacher.

Special Health Concerns

Each year we have multiple students with life threatening food allergies, including peanuts, tree nuts, and fish/shellfish. We would appreciate your assistance in reminding students not to share food at school. We also need your support in not providing class snacks or party treats that contain these items.

Vaccinations

If you receive a notice that your child needs another vaccination, please have it completed and send in the documentation. We do not want to have any of our students excluded due to lack of immunizations.

Medication Policy

Do Not Send Cough Drops with Students.

If your child has asthma, allergies (other than seasonal) or diabetes, please see me for a care plan form that must be completed by your child's physician. This must be updated each school year. At the end of the school year, all medications not picked up by a parent will be disposed of per state policy.
